PEC ELECTIONS 2018 – MAY 26TH-27TH

The PEC is a group of eight people (Fr. Paul and seven lay members) who are responsible for the management and oversight of our school. From setting policy to setting budgets; from raising funds to the expenditure of funds; from the maintenance of our school building and grounds to upholding the core values of our community, the PEC's role is to manage the school, its people and its resources for the benefit of our students.

Incumbents are allowed to serve on the PEC for up to eight (8) years. Each term is for a two (2) year period. In the first June meeting each year, the exiting members complete their term and new members are accepted. Positions on the PEC are discussed and generally filled to the individual's strengths. Consideration is given to positions requiring experience and continuity.

This year, there will be four openings for the two-year term from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020. Two of those openings will be filled by way of an election that will be held following the Masses on the weekend of **May 26-27, 2018**. The remaining openings will be filled by appointment by Fr. Paul. Those interested in running must have their nominations in by Wednesday, May 16th.

Attached to this newsletter is the nominations package containing more information about the process and the necessary forms for those interested in seeking a position.

FUNDRAISING – WALKATHON COMING UP

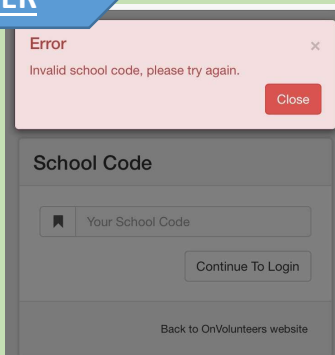
Thank you for all your support and participation in our recently completed fundraising activities – our **Family Bingo Night, Family Movie Night & Flea Market**.
